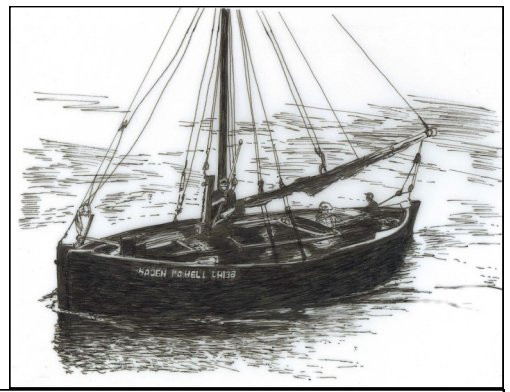


# *King's Lynn Worfolk Boat Trust*

The 10 mile/17Km Peter Scott Wash Walk,  
Sunday 10th May 2009.



Please help us to raise funds for the restoration of the Baden Powell, the first fishing boat to be built in Lynn by the Worfolk family. Walter Worfolk with sons Gerald and William constructed some 600 boats between 1900 and 1981. The Baden Powell is believed to be the last double ended fishing smack in existence, hence the urgency to save it from destruction.

From 10am onwards walkers start from the lighthouse on the Wingland, east side of the river Nene at Sutton Bridge. The wash walk is about 10 miles to West Lynn along the coastal path. Each walker will aim to have at least 10 sponsors and we invite each sponsor to give generously whatever he or she can afford.
